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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
EDGEMOOR CITIZENS ASSOCIATION, INC.

A Nonstock Corporation

I, Neal A. Jackson, being at least 18 years of age, hereby form a corporation under the general laws of the State of Maryland.

1. Name. The name of the corporation is Edgemoor Citizens Association, Inc.

2. Purposes. The corporation is organized for the purpose of advancing and protecting the interests of the residents within the membership area of the corporation; maintaining an attractive and safe neighborhood environment; fostering interest in the civic affairs of the community; and otherwise promoting the general welfare of the greater Edgemoor community.

3. Address. The address of the principal office of the corporation shall be 5210 Hampden Lane, Bethesda, Maryland 20814.

4. Name and Address of Resident Agent. The name and address of the resident agent shall be:

5. Stock. The corporation shall be a nonstock corporation.

6. Directors. The number of directors of the corporation shall be four, which number may be increased or decreased pursuant to the bylaws of the corporation, but shall never be less than three. The names of the directors who shall act until the first annual meeting or until their successors are duly chosen and/or qualified are: Stephen R. O'Neil, Andrew J. Haire III, Rosemary Berger, and Neal A. Jackson.

7. Powers. The corporation shall have all of the powers granted corporations under the laws of the State of Maryland. However, notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the corporation shall exercise only such powers as are in furtherance of the exempt purposes of organizations set forth in the subsection of Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code under which the corporation chooses to qualify for exemption, as the same now exists, or as it may be amended from time to time.

8. Distribution or Dissolution. In the event of the dissolution of the association, no member shall be entitled to any distribution or division of its remaining property or its proceeds, and the balance of all money and other property received by the association from any source after the payment of all debts and obligations of the association, shall be used or distributed exclusively for purposes within

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the intendment of Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code as the same now exists or as it may be amended from time to time.

9. Members. The corporation shall have two classes of members, general members and voting members. General members shall consist of all persons residing within the corporation's membership area as the same may be set forth in the bylaws of the corporation. Voting members shall be general members who have paid their dues as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors.
