The Montgomery County Volunteer Center maintains a list of non-profit organizations that accept items in good condition for reuse. Check out their “Quick Guide to Organizations that Receive Donated Goods.” You can also send a list of the items you want to donate, including a brief description of each item, and they will include your items in their bi-weekly email list of items available, which they send to over 1,000+ agencies and organizations.
